*The sponsors will encourage citizens and especially landowners to unite and challenge the Lost Pines Groundwater Conservation District to address their concerns about the permit's impacts on water supply and property rights. The District says it is the "only tool available" to protect the water supply of Bastrop and Lee Counties!*

-We will lead a forum addressing the process of protesting a proposed groundwater export permit for the LCRA. Frequently asked questions will be addressed first and then we will strategize about steps we will need to take, as a community, to gain access to the permitting process through a formal protest.

- Individuals, organizations and groups from Lee and Bastrop counties are encouraged to bring their questions as well as information to share about any wells on their property. Please try to have your well information including: depth, aquifer well is in, location and if your well is registered. (We will have forms and info for protesting the permit, registering your well with the District, and having the District measure your well levels. We'll discuss!)

- Simsboro wells are of particular interest!

- If you don't have a well but are willing to join in contesting the permit, we'll tell you ways you can do that – please come too!
